Unfinished Business:

1. Review Academic Affairs Committee Minutes from 10/9/23

Annemarie Hamlin motioned to approve minutes with edits, Kiri Simning, motion passed unanimously.

Action Item: Adoption of Student Technology and Privacy Policy (G-30-24), Kristine Roshau, 1st Reading

- 1. The aim is to modify and set a standard for existing practice.
- 2. The College will disclose to students the academic technology that we use, in regards to Instruction.
- a. Kristine Roshau is currently working with ITS to make sure this is FERPA compliant.
- 3. The instructor has the right and ability to require that a student utilizes certain technologies, in accordance with the syllabi.
- 4. Ralph Phillips noted that students may be using technologies external to the College, such as Twitter or personal emails. How would due diligence apply to these external technologies?
 - a. Kristine Roshau stated that this will only apply to single sign-on resources relevant to the College, not third-party platforms.
 - b. If the student is accessing a technology via Canva single sign-on authentication, then that would fall under due diligence.
- 5. Is there overlap between the privacy policy from the website, and this documentation?
 - a. This could be an addendum to the privacy policy.
- 6. OER or other such resources that pass information back to the gradebook would need to go through the College technology assessment process.
 - a. For technologies that need to be accessed, you would submit a technology request form to eLearning.

- 7. Annemarie Hamlin noted that Office of Academic Affairs should replace Office of Instruction.
- 8. It would be useful if this policy included draft language that can be incorporated into the syllabit template.
 - a. Kristine Roshau will include draft language for the 2nd reading.
- 9. This will be split into various proposals.
- 10. Kristine Roshau will discuss this with Sharla Andresen, in order to make sure that the College won't be liable if a data breach occurs.
