## **Accelerated Certificates**

The Office of Assessment and Curriculum proposes the creation of a new certificate category, "Accelerated Certificates," which would be comprised of independent certificates that take less than one year to complete. The catalog currently offers three types of certificates of completion:

- Two-Year Certificates of Completion, 36-108 credits
- One-Year Certificates of Completion, 36-71 credits
- Career Pathway Certificates of Completion (CPCCs), 12-35 credits

CPCCs are only available as credentials embedded in larger programs of 36 credits or more, which leaves a gap in COCC's available credentials. There are no non-CPCC short-term certificates (i.e., certificates that fall into the 12-35 credit range). The proposed Accelerated Certificate would be available for programs of 12-35 credits; this would mirror the credit range of CPCCs, but these certificates would not need to be embedded in larger programs of 36+ credits. Approving this certificate category would allow for its inclusion in the AY 24-25 Catalog.

This proposal has been shared with A&R, MPR, and CAP Services, and all parties support the "Accelerated Certificate" title. MPR noted that such a title was well-aligned with the Strategic Plans' "Student-Ready" goal.
