STUDENT IMPACT

- Removes unnecessary barrier for a majority NCDS students (approximately 77% of Fall 2023 NCDS students are taking a course that does not have a prerequisite or require placement.)
- Easier process for some grant funded initiatives, such as Community Health Worker, Peer Support, Automotive (Warm Springs), etc.
- Reduces the need for manual enrollment processes
- Removes confusing 'Placement Exception List' causing a manual registration process for students and admissions.

ANTICIPATED IMPLEMENTATION TIMELINE

Fall of 2024 to align with changes to Math courses and a shift from recommended prerequisites to required prerequisites. This would require implementation by the end of May, 2024 for NCDS registration.

Non-Degree Seeking Students & Placement

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What we are proposing

Remove placement as a required <u>enrollment</u> step for NCDS students and allow it to be managed at the course level.

Example

A non-degree seeking student looking to take a WR and BA course would experience the following:

BA 101 – Apply and register with no placement requirement WR 121Z – Apply, required to complete placement at the point of registration

You may not need to take the placement assessment if you plan to take only the following courses:

- HD 110 (Career Planning)
- HD 190 (Latino Leadership)
- Music Performance
- HHP Activity
- · Studio art
- Computer Skills (CIS below 100-level)
- Foreign Language
- Community Healthcare
- Peer Support

 - 638 total NCDS students
 - 507 if you exclude College Now
- 790 total registrations
 - 10% required prerequisite
 - 13% recommended prerequisite
 - 77% no required or recommended prerequisite
