

### TRANSFER AGREEMENT

# Central Oregon Community College with Pacific Northwest College of Art

This Transfer Agreement is entered into and by and between Pacific Northwest College of Art ("PNCA") and Central Oregon Community College ("COCC").

It is in the interest of both COCC and PNCA to facilitate the transfer of qualified students from COCC to PNCA.

NOW THEREFORE, the parties for good and sufficient consideration agree as follows:

PNCA agrees to accept credits for students transferring from COCC to PNCA, as outlined in Exhibit A, Transfer Criteria, and Table A, which are hereby incorporated and made part of this agreement.

#### Terms and Conditions

- A. Term: Termination. This agreement shall commence on the date of last signature and shall terminate on January 1, 2023 unless terminated earlier as provided herein. This Agreement shall be effective for students who apply to transfer from COCC to PNCA beginning with PNCA's Fall or Spring term. This agreement may be renewed for additional terms of any length by the mutual written agreement of the parties. Either party may terminate or suspend this Agreement for convenience upon sixty (60) days written notice; provided, however, that the parties shall discuss and reasonably attempt to resolve the issues that led to the notice of termination or suspension during the sixty (60) day period. Notwithstanding the termination of this Agreement, any students who have applied for transfer from COCC to PNCA prior or during the sixty (60) day period shall be treated as if this Agreement continues to be in effect. This Agreement may also be terminated as provided elsewhere in this agreement.
- B. <u>Admissions:</u> Admission to PNCA is not guaranteed. Students shall apply for admission to PNCA in accordance with then-existing rules, policies, and procedures of PNCA.
- C. General Provisions:

1. Contract Administration. The representatives for purposes of administering this agreement are: For PNCA:

- 2. Termination Due to Non-Appropriation of Funds. If sufficient funds are not provided in future budgets of PNCA to permit PNCA in the exercise of its reasonable administrative discretion to continue this Agreement, or if PNCA or any program for which this agreement was established is abolished, this agreement may be terminated without further liability by not less than 30 days written notice to the COCC and Contract Administration.
- 3. No Third Party Beneficiaries. PNCA and COCC are the only parties to this agreement and are the only parties entitled to enforce its terms.
- 4. Execution and Counterparts. This Agreement may be executed in several counterparts, each of which shall be an original, all of which shall constitute but one and the same instrument.
- 5. Merger. This agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the parties. No waiver, consent, modification, or change of terms of this agreement shall bind either party unless in writing and signed by both parties. Such waiver, consent, modification, or change, if made, shall be effective only in the specific instance and for the specific purpose given. There are no understandings, agreements, or representations-oral or written- not specified herein regarding this agreement.

Intro to World Art History, Art History- 200 level elective.	Block transfer 4 quarters required courses for 2 semesters: Either ARH 201, or 202, ARH 203, ARH 206, and ARH 208 (Non Western Art).
Perspectives on Society and Culture	Any 4 credit class from the social sciences.
Math and Science	Any 4 credit class from Math or Natural Science.
Theory and Practice	Substitute 200 level Humanities, theory, or political science class, or take at PNCA. Portfolio should reflect some awareness of theory and contemporary issues in art
4 Studio electives/ major requirements- 2 semesters	Block transfer 4 semesters for 6 quarters of any studio art electives. Take classes that supports student's major interests

\*Students with the above requirements fulfilled (C or better grade point average) would automatically enter PNCA as a junior with at least 60 credits, with 4 full time semesters left to complete. To finish the sophomore year, most students would need to take History of (their major) in addition to sophomore requirements of their major, but this would be offset by having completed a 200 level Art history elective. Upon successful portfolio review, all credits will have been accepted and transferred in a minimum credit ratio of 3 quarters=2 semesters. Note: Credit base was not used for calculating transfer, but rather contact hours and course content.

Design, Illustration, Animation, and Video/Sound majors may have additional 2<sup>nd</sup> year requirements. It is recommended that all students take courses related to expected major interest, and that Graphic Design majors also take History of Graphic Design. Requirements can be waived by strength of portfolio upon review by Chair of department, though credits must still be earned.

If a student at COCC gets the proper advising, especially in the aspect of the "Major requirement" then they may indeed transfer in at the 60 semester credit level at PNCA.
