**Congratulations! The Central Oregon Community College's "Community Health Worker Training Program" training program has met the Traditional Health Worker training standards described in OAR 410-180-0350 through 410-180-0380. The program is approved by the Oregon Health Authority (OHA) to train community health workers from April 4, 2014 to April 3, 2017.**

During the approval period, the organization agrees to:

- Make this written notice of OHA approval available to any student or partnering organization that requests a copy and, to the extent possible, display this notice at the main training center;
- Issue a written letter of completion to all successful program graduates;
- Verify the names of graduates to OHA when those individuals apply for certification;
- Report to OHA changes to the program within 30 days of the decision to make the change;
- Apply to renew its approval status at least 6 months prior to the expiration of approval;
- Allow OHA to conduct potential site visits during the approval period or renewal process.
