



Pit & Fissure Sealants for Dental Assistants

This Oregon Board of Dentistry approved course teaches Expanded Function Dental Assistants (EFDA) the placement of pit and fissure sealants. Attendees will receive their curriculum completion form after successfully completing the course and providing a copy of their EFDA certification. The morning session includes lecture followed by a 25-question multiple choice exam. An 80% or better score is required to proceed to the lab/clinical sessions in the afternoon. Each student must bring a patient for the clinical part of the class and supply some materials.

What Students Need to Bring:

- A copy of your EFDA certificate. (If you are not yet EFDA certified, we will hold your course completion form until you become certified)
- You must bring a patient for the clinical part of the class (afternoon). Your patient must have a signed prescription form from their dentist for the placement of at least two pit and fissure sealants. This prescription must be signed no more than 45 days before the sealant placement date (January 31, 2019).
- Your office's preferred Pit and Sealant material for at least 4 sealants (if you are not working at an office, sealant material will be provided at class)
- Two extracted virgin posterior teeth (do not autoclave)
- Two 'basic' set-ups
- Etchant with tips
- Toothbrushes for Patient/s
