Other software and hardware	<p>Word processing software (i.e. Microsoft Word)</p> <p>Up-to-date Java, Adobe Reader and Adobe Flash Player (Click on each product name for free download)</p> <p>Speakers to listen to the video audio</p> <p>NOTE: Microsoft Word or PDF are the only acceptable file formats for the writing assignments.
