Valid to Employment Authorized."</li> <li>A stamp indicating that the student has been paroled into the United States for at least one year, wit a date that has not expired.</li> <li>"Cuban-Haitian Entrant".</li> <li>Victims of human trafficking with I-94 coded as T1, T2, T3, or T COA.</li> </ul> </li> <li>Violence Against Women Act (VAWA):         <ul> <li>Provide a I-797 form or Certification Letter indicating establishment of prima facie case.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
