



Your Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) was selected for review in a process called "Verification." In this process, the Financial Aid Office will compare information from your FAFSA with the financial documents you provide and make any necessary corrections. Corrections may affect your eligibility for aid. For students who are selected for verification, files may take a number of weeks to be reviewed after all documents are submitted. Additionally, the Financial Aid Office may request further information to complete the review process and financial aid may be held until all requested documentation is submitted and verification is complete.

- Other people if they now live with the student and the student or spouse provides **more than half of their support** and will continue to provide more than half of their support through June 30, 2018.

Note: If you share a residence with a domestic partner, do not include the domestic partner or their dependents unless you personally provide more than 50% of their support.
