

Adobe Acrobat – Fixing the PDF viewer

What

When you open a PDF, it opens in Microsoft Edge instead of Adobe Acrobat. Many people find this interface annoying.

Where

- Click on the “Start” button.
- On the tiles to the right, click “Control Panel”
- From the list, select “Default Programs”
- Select the first item “Set your default programs”

Information

Windows 10 is set up to use the Edge browser to view pdf documents. What makes this annoying is that all the controls you are used to having in Adobe Acrobat Viewer are missing. So you may want to tell the computer to use Adobe Acrobat to view your pdf documents.

1. Navigate to the location in the “Where” instructions up above.
2. Click on “Adobe Acrobat Reader DC”
3. On the right hand side, click on “Set this program as default”

You may also want to consider doing the same for “Windows Media Player” (This makes your life easier when playing voicemail messages.)
