# **Presidents Report:**

Raymond agrees that maybe rather than adding something to the bylaws regarding being a part of clubs, we should take the initiative to be a part of things.

  there is a lack of outreach to online students, or other campuses.
   Creating/promoting Social media. Touching up the Student Resources page on
  the COCC website. Hannah suggests creating a central hub on the student login
  page containing all the information that students need to be more involved.
   Rather than having to do a lot of searching to find a resource page, it could be
  more easily accessible.
- Neil suggests creating an alert system to let the Bend ASCOCC know if the Redmond food bank is running low.
- Hannah wanted to find a way to allow students to know what ASCOCC is doing and accomplishing.

### - Changes to the Professional Development Fund:

Those who would like to use the professional development fund need to come up with a proposal and pitch the idea to ASCOCC. The language of this fund is being changed. More specifics of the Professional Development Fund need to be decided and reviewed before voting. The process of voting on these changes was unanimously voted to be postponed until the next meeting.
