## **ASCOCC Council Resolution #101**

### **Section I**

**1.1 Whereas**, the services and benefits the American Red Cross provide are a great benefit to the surrounding community, the country and the world.

**1.2 Whereas**, the student body receives the opportunity to undergo meaningful professional development by hosting, organizing and staffing a campus blood drive.

**1.3 Whereas**, historically student clubs/organizations, such as the Criminal Justice club, have provided outstanding support and execution of campus wide blood drives.

**1.4 Whereas**, the Associated Students of COCC do intend to see student blood drives continue into the future with the support and help of the student body, including members of the student body that have formed a student club/organization.

### **Section II**

**2.1 Therefore, Be It Resolved**, the Associated Students of Central Oregon Community College will work with the American Red Cross, COCC Faculty, and the Student Body to schedule dates, reserve rooms, and promote college blood drives.

**2.2 Therefore, Be It Resolved**, the Associated Students of Central Oregon Community College will charge student clubs with staffing the blood drives as to gain the beneficial experience of organizing and executing a campus wide event.

**2.3 Therefore, Be It Resolved**, the Associated Students of Central Oregon Community College will only organize, staff and execute a campus wide student blood drive in the event that a student club/organization, or other body of students unaffiliated with ASCOCC, is unable or unwilling to participate.

**2.4 Therefore, Be It Resolved**, the Associated Students of Central Oregon Community College will provide funds for food and beverages for those students staffing the blood drive, and also for those students that are donating blood.
