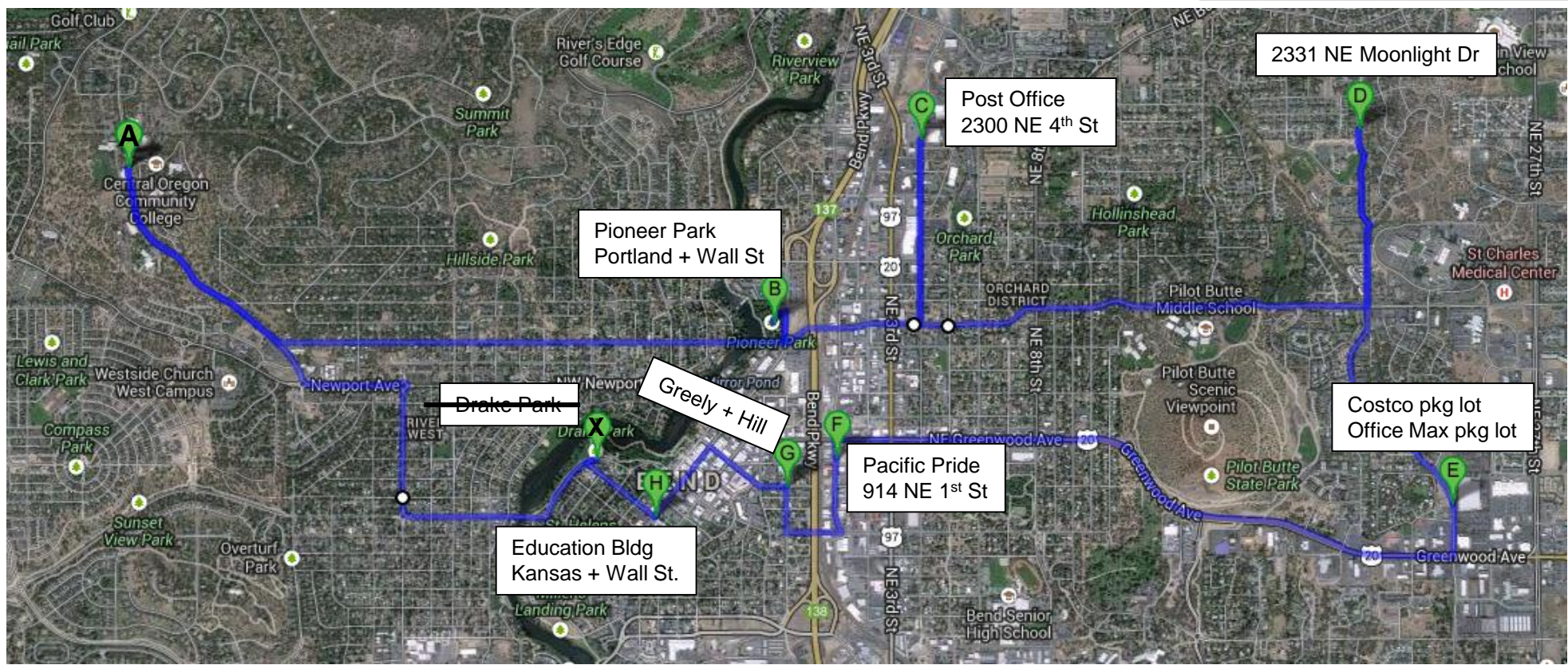


B:
In Pioneer Park, the *Picea pungens* trees will be near the roses at the more northern side. (there are *Picea engelmannii* at the south side of the park)

C:
At the post office, *Quercus garryana* is along the road by the sidewalk

D:
Populus italica var. *nigra* are very tall trees with large deltoid leaves. This is a private address but they know our class comes by to sample these trees 😊



H:
Philadelphus lewisii is on the NE corner of the education building
Abies concolor is over the stairs on the east side of the building
Picea abies is along the N side of the building and has large long cones

G (Greely and Hill):
Liriodendron tulipifera is on the NE side of the block
Aesculus hippocastanea is on the west side of the block

F:
Eleagnus angustifolia is on the sidewalk a little south of Pacific Pride
It is ALSO at location "G" near the *Aesculus hippocastanea*

E:
Tilia americana is along the road near the "E" on the map
Pinus sylvestris is between the Office Max and Costco parking lots
