



### Geography:

Indonesia is the largest archipelago in the world

Consists of 18,108 islands (per 2003 sat imaging, ASI)

Total area is slightly less than 3x the size of Texas

Only about 6,000 islands are inhabited



#### Population:

~ 263,991,379 people (per Wikipedia- UN 2017 World Population Prospects)

4th most populace nation in the world (China, India, USA)

~ 60% of the population lives on Java (only 7% of the land area)

"Transmigrasi" - government program to reduce population density in Java, etc.


